Rajesh Bindal, J.

The petitioners approached this Court challenging acquisition of land where notifications under Sections 4 and 6 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (for short, 'the Act'), were issued on 29.1.2003 and 28.1.2004, respectively.

The stand taken by the State in the reply filed is that award pertaining to the land in question was announced on 27.1.2006. The possession of the land was handed over by the Collector to HSIIDC. The supplementary award for the superstructure was announced on 27.2.2007. The amount of compensation for the acquired land and the superstructure existing thereon was received by the petitioners. Not only this, the enhanced compensation as determined by the learned Reference Court under Section 18 of the Act has also been received by the petitioners.

Considering the aforesaid facts, we do not find that any case is made out for interference in the present writ petition, once the petitioners have not only received the amount of compensation awarded by the Collector but even the enhanced compensation as determined by the learned Reference Court.

The writ petition stands dismissed.
