The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.64 dated 14.8.2016 under sections 341, 323, 148, 149 I.P.C (sections 326 and 307 I.P.C were added later on), registered at Police Station, Sekhwan, District Gurdaspur.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length.

FIR has been registered on the statement of Hansa Singh in relation to an occurrence that took place on 6.8.2016. As per accusations, complainant Hansa Singh as also his sons Kashmir Singh and Kuldeep Singh are stated to have been assaulted by the accused party including the present petitioner.

In so far as the present petitioner is concerned, there is a specific attribution of having given iron rod blows on the person of Kashmir Singh. The injuries suffered by Kashmir Singh have been opined to be grievous as also dangerous to life and thereby attracting offence under sections 326 and 307 I.P.C.

In the light of such specific attribution and the seriousness of the offence, I am not inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition, accordingly, is dismissed.
