Petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No. 138 dated 01.09.2016 under Section 326-A IPC registered at Police Station C-Division, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

The FIR was lodged by Rajni on the allegations that since 30.08.2016, petitioner was involved in throwing packets of acid continuously in her house.

On 01.09.2016 also, petitioner threw a packet of acid on the complainant when she was coming from the street. There was some previous history vis-a-vis involvement of the brother-in-law of the petitioner in respect of affair with younger sister of the complainant.

As per medico legal report, no external injury was found, rather burning sensation on the Dorso Lateral Aspect of Left Foot was recorded in the MLR.

Apparently, there was no previous complaint filed by the complainant in respect of previous incidents of throwing packets of acid by the petitioner in the house of the complainant.

The petitioner is in custody since 01.09.2016. Challan has already been presented.

Without embarking upon merits of the case, in my opinion, prayer for regular bail of the petitioner can be considered.

In view of above, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
