Petitioners-Amarjit Kaur and Jaswinder Kaur have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.308 dated 20.10.2016, registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar, under Sections 420/120-B IPC.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that prima facie, the dispute looks to be of civil nature regarding possession. The petitioners have already joined the investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation. Nothing is to be recovered from them. No useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case;

without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 07.12.2016, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
