Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petition earlier filed by the petitioner seeking bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. (CRM-M-11959-2017), was dismissed by this Court on 10.05.2017 essentially for the reason that the petitioner was seen to have been accused of having committed an offence punishable under Section 302 IPC in another case, with yet another case also registered against him.

He submits that in one of the cases, the petitioner has been released on bail and as regards the present case, though the allegation against the petitioner is that he and his co-accused fired shots at the complainant party, there was no injury caused to anybody and yet further, the petitioner is not being produced before the trial Court on various dates that the case has been fixed for proceedings, as can be seen from the orders Annexure P-2. Thus the trial is lingering on for that other reasons.

nobody was injured in the occurrence and the trial is still at the initial stage with charges having been amended on 18.12.2017 and 36 prosecutions witnesses to be examined.

Keeping in view all the above facts, with the petitioner also having been in custody in the present FIR for 1 year and 2 months as admitted by learned State counsel on query, it is considered appropriate that upon furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court, he be released on bail.

Ordered accordingly.
