LISA GILL, J.

This petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 116 dated 07.08.2014 dated 07.08.2014 registered under Sections 354,323,341 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short) at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar, on the basis of a settlement (**Annexure P-2**) stated to be arrived at between the parties.

Notice was issued in this case on 07.12.2016 and the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate on 05.01.2017 for recording of their statements in regard to the settlement arrived at between them. As per report dated 30.01.2017 submitted by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nakodar, it is mentioned that the petitioner is in custody in some other case. He was not produced for recording of his statement on the date fixed. Respondent No. 2 and 3 also did not appear in the Court. No request was forthcoming for another occasion to record the statements. It is noted that none has appeared on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 despite service even though the matter was adjourned to await their appearance.

Learned counsel for the petitioners at this stage seeks to withdraw this petition with liberty to file afresh, after ascertaining whether the compromise between the parties still stands.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
