Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.988 dated 02.10.2017, under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Karnal.

The petitioner was arrested on 02.10.2017 and is in jail since then. The prosecution case is that 7 kg 900 grams of contraband was recovered from the police.

Looking to the date of arrest of the petitioner, i.e. 02.10.2017 and in order to give him a chance to reform, I think the petitioner should be granted the relief of bail.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Petitioner shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall deposit his passport, if possesses, with the trial Court. Petitioner shall file

undertaking before the trial Court that he will not indulge in similar or any other kind of offences in future. Petitioner shall attend the police station concerned between 10:00 AM to 04:00 PM on Sunday every week. Petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well. In case of violation, the prosecution is at liberty to apply for cancellation of bail.
