This is a petition for grant of regular bail in FIR No.207 dated 08.12.2014, under Sections 22/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Shimlapuri, District Ludhiana. Petitioner was arrested and is in jail.

Learned State counsel submits that three witnesses have been examined by the prosecution. No other case is stated by the learned State counsel to be reported against the petitioner.

Looking to the above and further looking to the FSL report the salt less than 30%, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. The petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
