This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for setting aside the order dated 21.08.2015 passed by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Jalandhar and order dated 29.01.2015 passed by learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar.

During the pendency of the instant petition, the petitioner had been directed to deposit a sum of Rs.15,000/- towards litigation expenses with the Registry, payable to the respondent and the same was deposited. Despite notices having been issued, no one put in appearance on behalf of the respondent.

Today, this court is informed by counsel for the petitioner that matter stands compromised between the parties and he seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition. Apart from above, it is prayed that the amount of litigation expenses that stands deposited, be released to the
