At the asking of the Court, Ms. Anju Arora, Addl.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice. A complete copy of the paper book has been handed over to learned State counsel, in the Court.

It is contended that it was a matrimonial dispute which has been amicably settled between the parties. The couple has decided to part ways and a joint petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, has already been filed. In pursuance of the order passed by this Court in connected petition bearing No.CRM-M-17603-2017, the accused-petitioners therein were directed to get their statements recorded before the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate with regard to the veracity of the compromise.
