The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.173 dated 30.8.2008 under sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Chandimandir, District Panchkula.

During the course of arguments it has been conceded by the counsel that having evaded the trial proceedings petitioner was declared as a Proclaimed Offender on 8.11.2013.

Petitioner seeks to gain impetus from the fact that the other three co-accused, who faced trial have since been acquitted in the light of judgement dated 3.3.2014.

Be that as it may, conduct of the petitioner in having evaded the trial proceedings disentitles him from the concession of bail.

Petition, accordingly, is dismissed.
