RITU BAHRI, J.

Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of FIR No. 179 dated 13.7.2012 under Sections 323, 354, 451, 506, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar on the basis of compromise deed dated 3.12.2016 (Annexure P-2).

As per allegations in the FIR, respondent No. 2 was coming back from her another house to her residential house where petitioners No. 1, 2 and 3 entered her house and gave her beatings. The paternal uncle of respondent No. 2 saved her. On this background, FIR was got registered. During the pendency of petition, the matter has been duly compromised.

In compliance of order dated 8.12.2016, report dated 19.12.2016 of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Nakodar has been received in this regard. As per report, statement of parties have been recorded. Complainant-respondent No.2 stated that the matter stands compromised between the parties and she does not want to proceed further against the accused and has no objection, if the present F.I.R be quashed against the petitioners. The compromise has been entered voluntarily. To the same effect is the statements given by petitioners.

Consequently, in view of the status report dated 19.12.2016 and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Dr. Arvind Barsaul etc. versus State of Madhya Pradesh and another 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 910***, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No. 179 dated 13.7.2012 under Sections 323, 354, 451, 506, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
