Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C is for direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to ensure that respondent No.3 does not implicate the petitioner or his family members in any false case.

Reply by way of affidavit of Narinder Pal Singh, PPS, Fazilka has already been filed. As per reply, on 21.06.2014, respondent No.3 was transferred to CIA Staff Fazilka on deputation. However, on 22.03.2016, the said respondent has been shifted in SSP Office, Fazilka. As such he is not working with the CIA Staff, Fazilka any more.

In view of the aforesaid reply submitted by the respondents, the prayer made by the petitioner no more survives as the respondent No.3 has already been transferred from CIA staff, Fazilka and is posted in the Office of the SSP, Fazilka.

Mr. Yogesh Goel, Advocate appearing for respondent No.3

states that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

In view of the stand of the official respondents that the respondent No.3 is no more working with CIA Staff, the present petition no more survives and is disposed of as such.
