Counsel for the petitioner would state that as per his instructions, dispute between the parties has been settled by way of compromise and in pursuance thereof, the petitioner and the complainant have filed a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act for divorce by way of mutual consent.

Counsel for the State of Punjab concedes to this fact that dispute between the parties has been settled.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) He shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- (ii) He shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and*
- (iii) He shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.*
