The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.34 dated 02.04.2016 registered under Section 20 of NDPS Act at Police Station Bhikhi, District Mansa.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner being a woman and was arrested on 02.04.2016, is still in jail. There is no other offence reported against the petitioner. The sample of 100 grams *sulpha* was taken separately.

The petitioner would be entitled to grant of benefit of Section 437 Cr.P.C. Accordingly, the petition for regular bail is allowed.
