Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.221 dated 07.10.2017 registered under Sections 148/149/186/188/307/323/332/353/379 IPC at Police Station Hassanpur, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 07.10.2017 and as per the allegation in the FIR, one Sanjay had tried to run over the police party with a tractor and when the police tried to chase him, petitioner obstructed them in performance of their duties. It is further submitted that Section 307 IPC has been deleted during investigation and nothing is recovered from the petitioner. It is also submitted that 8 persons were named in the FIR while 10 persons were named as unknown in the FIR. It is also submitted that only the petitioner was arrested by the police while the main accused Sanjay has not been arrested. As per MLR, simple injuries were caused to the complainant.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Majlish Singh

has not disputed the factual position but opposed the bail on the ground that the petitioner is known to the main accused.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view the fact that no specific role has been attributed to the petitioner and the fact that the simple injuries were caused to the complainant, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner – Jagat Singh is directed to be released on bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Palwal.
