Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.78 dated 19.07.2017 registered under Sections 22, 27-A, 29, 61, 85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Moti Nagar, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 19.07.2017 and report of Chemical Examiner is still awaited. Learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the decision of the Division Bench of this Court passed in ***Inderjeet Singh @ Laddi and ors. vs. State of Punjab, 2014(3) RCR (Crl.) 953*** wherein this Court has observed that till the receiving of chemical examination report/FSL, the accused person can be released on interim bail subject to furnishing his undertaking that he will surrender before the trial Court as and when report is received.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Jaspal Singh has not disputed the fact that the report of FSL is still awaited.

Considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the

parties and keeping in view the decision in *Inderjeet Singh @ Laddi and ors.'s case (supra)*, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to be satisfaction of the trial Court with an undertaking to be filed via member of Panchayat or Lambardar of the village that the petitioner will surrender before the trial Court as and when the FSL report is received.

The present petition is disposed of.
