Through the present petition, quashing of FIR No.118, dated 24.02.2015, registered under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506 IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines Karnal, District Karnal is sought for on the basis of compromise(Annexure P-2).

Through order of this Court dated 24.01.2017, the parties were directed to appear before the Ilaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate with regard to the compromise effected between them.

The report dated 10.03.2017 from the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal, has been received, as per which the parties recorded their statements before the trial Court in terms of the compromise arrived at between them.

Learned State counsel has also no objection if the present petition is allowed.

In view of the above, continuation of the proceedings in pursuance of the afore-referred FIR which pertains to a matrimonial

dispute between the parties and the matter having been compromised, would be an abuse of the process of law and in terms of the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others versus State of Haryana and others, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, I deem it just and proper to allow the petition and resultantly quash the FIR No.118, dated 24.02.2015, registered under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506 IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines Karnal, District Karnal, and all proceedings arising therefrom.
