The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.63 dated 23rd April, 2017, registered under Sections 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, 'the NDPS Act') at Police Station Subhanpur, Kapurthala District Kapurthala.

Custody certificate of the petitioner filed in the Court today; Be kept on record.

It transpires that the petitioner is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

Admittedly, the recovery made from the present petitioner was marginally above the commercial limit.

Considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, this Court is of the opinion that he is covered by the ratio of various decisions of Co-ordinate Benches of this Court, which have been referred to in case of '**Satnam Singh @ Satta Vs. State of Punjab-CRM-M No.7320 of 2017**'.

The present petitioner, namely Paramjit Singh may therefore be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Area Magistrate concerned.

However, no observation contained in any part of this order shall have any bearing on the ultimate decision after trial.
