This order shall dispose of aforesaid two petitions as common facts are involved therein.

The complainant-Rattan Kumar has filed the aforesaid two petitions seeking cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to accused-Surjit Singh and Mrs. Rinku Suniari, vide order dated 07.09.2015 (**Annexure**

P-3), passed by this Court in case FIR No.87 dated 09.07.2015, under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Chabbewal, District Hoshiarpur.

The plea raised for cancellation of the bail is that both the aforesaid accused/respondents are threatening the petitioner/complainant from deposing before the Court.

At the time of hearing, learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Mohinder Singh and learned Counsel for respondent No.2/both the accused, state that the petitioner/complainant-Rattan Kumar has already been examined on 11.05.2017 and, therefore, the alleged apprehension no longer survives.

In view of the above, the aforesaid petitions are dismissed.
