The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.587 dated 31.10.2015, for the offence under Sections 498-A,323, 506, 377 IPC registered at Police Station Saran, District Faridabad, Haryana (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 28.11.2016 (Annexure P-2) before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Vide order dated 25.04.2016 in the connected petition i.e. CRM-M-13559 of 2016 titled Ashok Kumar Vs. State of Haryana, petitioner was granted interim bail and thereafter, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. As per report of the Mediator, the dispute in the matter has been amicably resolved and in terms of the compromise, parties are ready to stay together under one roof and agreed for getting the FIR quashed on the basis of this compromise.

Learned counsel for the parties have put in appearance and

submits that both the husband and wife are residing happily together.

Consequently, in view of the status report and the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of Madan Mohan Abbot vs. State of Punjab 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 429, the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in the case of Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052, this Court is of the view that no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No.587 dated 31.10.2015, for the offence under Sections 498-A, 323, 506, 377 IPC registered at Police Station Saran, District Faridabad, Haryana (Annexure P-1) is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
