Petitioner-Rahul @ Bachi has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.295 dated 05.06.2017, registered at Police Station Mahendergarh, under Sections 148, 149, 294, 323, 341, 379-B and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the FIR, the present petitioner alongwith co-accused stopped the vehicle of the complainant, caused injuries to him and also took away ₹4,000/- and mobile phone

from him. Three of the accused have been named in the FIR.

The injuries are stated to be simple in nature. The petitioner has been in custody since 02.08.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
