This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R No. 625 dated 20.09.2016, under Sections 376-D, 506 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station, Civil Lines, Hisar, District Hisar.

Upon notice, reply on behalf of respondent-State, by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police (HQ), Hisar, has been filed, wherein it has been stated that on an application dated 29.09.2016 made by the petitioner to the Superintendent of Police, Hisar, the enquiry was conducted by Bhagwan Dass, Deputy Superintendent of Police (HQ), Hisar, whereupon all the accused were found to be the real culprits. Superintendent of Police, Hisar filed the same on the basis of enquiry report dated 15.10.2016 submitted by Bhagwan Dass, DSP. Thereafter, another application was received by the Superintendent of Police, Hisar, which was marked to Ms. Geetika Jhakar, DSP, Women, Police Station, Hisar on

namely Sham Sunder, Karan, Rinku, Ishant, Deepak, Mohit and Sourabh were found to be the real culprits. The enquiry report dated 27.12.2016 was submitted to the Superintendent of Police, Hisar. The investigation is still going on in the matter.

After going through the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is of the view that the offences alleged to have been committed by the accused-petitioner are of serious nature.

Keeping in view the seriousness of the offence, no case for anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
