The present petition has been filed under Section 438 the Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.170 dated 29.10.2016 registered under Section 379 IPC and Section 21(2) of Mines and Mineral Regulations of Development Act, 1957 at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar.

On 15.12.2016 this Court had passed the following order:-

“Contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the instant case. In fact, the tractor in question was removed from the house of the petitioner.

Post again on 01.02.2017.

The petitioner is allowed to join the investigation.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the

Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
3. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 15.12.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the order dated 15.12.2016 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to furnishing of bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioner to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
