Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties.

This petition is directed against the order dated 30.8.2010 framing charge. A perusal of the zimni orders shows that there is no stay order by this Court and the case is pending since the year 2010. Learned Counsel for the petitioners fairly states that the trial has commenced and some witnesses have been examined. In my opinion, at such a late stage, it would not be feasible for this Court to interfere when the trial has already commenced and this Court would not deem it proper to stall the trial. In that view of the matter, the following order is passed:-

ORDER

- (i) CRR-3021-2010 is disposed of with a direction to the trial court to complete the trial expeditiously and in any case within six months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order;
- (ii) all the points are kept open for being canvassed before the trial court.
