In the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner prays for quashing of FIR No.33 dated 06.06.2014 under Section 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (in short 'IPC') registered with Police Station D- Division, Amritsar City, order dated 28.10.2015 (Annexure P-5) and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of compromise/affidavits dated 26.11.2015(Annexure P-2 and P-3).

The complainant and the alleged victim of the crime did not come forward to concede to the factum of compromise between the parties. Rather they refused to accept the summons issued by the Court, sufficient to show that plea of the petitioner that dispute has been settled by way of compromise is mis-conceived.

In view of the above, the present petition fails and is accordingly dismissed.
