**JITENDRA CHAUHAN.J.(ORAL)**

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No. 172 dated 31.12.2015, registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Balachaur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had secured a loan of Rs.50,000/- from co-accused Narinder Pal. The petitioner being illiterate was taken to the Registration Authority on the ground of preparation of certain documents with regard to loan allegedly secured by the petitioner. However, as per the FIR, the petitioner has been projected as owner of the land. No amount was entrusted to the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody for the last more than six months.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel submits

that the petitioner actually participated in the crime. He, in fact ,is the

main accused who was projected as owner of the land in question allegedly sold for Rs.67 lakh.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the case file.

It is to be noticed that co-accused Narinder Pal and Pritpal Singh have been declared proclaimed offenders. A huge sum of Rs.67 lakh was allegedly received by the accused along with the petitioner who was set up as owner of the land in question. Considering the active role played by the petitioner and the huge amount allegedly received by the petitioner, no case for bail is made out at this stage. Consequently, the petition is dismissed.
