Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already joined the investigation on the date fixed and has also submitted a bank draft in a sum of Rs.1 lac in the name of the complainant before the Investigating Officer.

Let bank draft submitted by the petitioner be given to the complainant. Petitioner is ready to pay an amount of Rs.70,000/- through a demand draft in the name of the complainant within one month.

In view of aforesaid, the order dated 09.12.2016 passed by this Court is made absolute subject to deposit of amount of Rs.70,000/- within a period of one month in the shape of demand draft in the name of the complainant without prejudice to his civil right in ultimate decision of the case, failing which the complainant would have a right to seek cancellation of anticipatory bail.
