Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.67 dated 20.04.2017 registered under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala Police, District Batala, on the basis of compromise (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 16.11.2017 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, Gurdaspur, within a week for recording their statements qua compromise with a direction to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to furnish a report regarding veracity thereof, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Batala on 22.11.2017 and got recorded their statements. Report from the concerned Magistrate has been received vide letter No. 160 dated 07.12.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur vide endorsement No. 20363/RKT dated 08.12.2017.

According to the report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Batala, the compromise effected between the parties is genuine, which is not the result of any pressure or coercion.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No. 67 is quashed qua the petitioners, subject to depositing costs of Rs. **10,000/-** by the petitioners with the Punjab Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh within one week, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
