Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner pointed out to me order dated November 11, 2016 (Annexure P-4) granting bail to Pal Kaur alias Satpal Kaur. This Court has passed the said order after reading the evidence of Kawaljit Kaur (PW-1).

Seen the FIR. Insofar as the present petitioner-Charanjit Kaur, is concerned there is direct evidence of overt act on the part of the petitioner, prima facie, that she had brought lincenced 12 bore gun along with cartridge belt from the room and handed over the same to Nirmal Singh who ultimately fired. Two persons died in the incident, i.e. the husband and father-in-law of the complainant Kawaljit Kaur.

The case of the petitioner-Charanjit Kaur, therefore, cannot be compared on parity with Pal Kaur alias Satpal Kaur. Hence the petition for bail is dismissed.
