This petition has been filed under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No.2 vide order dated 07.10.2017 (Annexure P-3) passed by this Court in FIR No.30 dated 23.04.2017 registered under Sections 498-A and 406 of Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Learned State counsel on instructions state that though the statement made by the Investigating Officer before the trial Court was found to be against record to the extent that respondent No.2 was not required for custodial interrogation and on the statement made, the bail in question was allowed, however, there is no evidence of misuse of the order. An inquiry has already been initiated against respondent No.3.

Heard.

In view of the above, this Court feels that the order dated 07.10.2017 being not misused by respondent No.2, therefore, no case for cancellation of bail is made out. However, the proceedings initiated against respondent No.3 be completed expeditiously and a report in this regard within six weeks from today be sent to the Registrar of this Court.
