This petition under Section 482 of the Criminal Procedure Code has been filed for quashing of FIR No.48 dated 24.05.2010 registered under Section 364-A read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station District Batala, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that with the intervention of the relatives, the matter has been compromised between the parties. It is further contended that the instant FIR has been quashed by this Court vide order dated 15.09.2015 (Annexure P-3) qua co-accused.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the case file.

The petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender. Subsequently, he was taken into custody. Keeping in view the conduct of the petitioner, no case for quashing of the FIR is made out. Otherwise also,

offence under Section 364-A of IPC is serious in nature. The petitioner is rather misusing the process of the Court.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
