ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.101 dated 20.09.2017, under Sections 323/324/34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Nandgarh, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had caused an injury on the head of the complainant with a sharp-edged weapon. This injury has resulted in fracture over left parieto occipital region. Learned counsel further contends that the injuries were also inflicted on the arm and finger of the complainant, which are simple in nature. He also contends that the petitioner was also injured in the occurrence for which he had lodged a cross case but the MLR of the petitioner is not placed on record.

Heard.

In view of the serious nature of the injury allegedly caused by the petitioner with a sharp-edged weapon, which resulted in the fracture of the head of the complainant, I do not consider it to be a fit case to grant him the concession of anticipatory bail.

The petition stands dismissed.
