Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of order dated 14.05.2014 (Annexure P-30) whereby the petitioner has been declared proclaimed person in case F.I.R. No.54 dated 26.03.2009 under Section 420 IPC and Section 24 of Immigration Act, registered at Police Station Sector 31, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of present petition, the matter has been compromised between the parties and on the basis of compromise, a separate petition i.e. CRM-M-44550-2016 titled as 'Anu Sharma Versus Union Territory Chandigarh and another' seeking quashing of aforesaid FIR, has been filed.
