The instant petition was filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners by voicing apprehension to the same at the hands of the private respondents on account of having entered into matrimony against the wishes of the elders.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ravinder Kumar would apprise the Court that the petitioners have not approached respondent no.3 i.e. S.H.O., Police Station, Abohar City-1, District Fazilka as regards their apprehension. Rather the petitioners have been found to be not residing at the address furnished in the Memo of Parties at Abohar.

Counsel for the petitioners has not come present. It may be noticed that even on the last date of hearing i.e. on 6.2.2017 counsel did not appear.

The only inference that can be drawn by this Court is that the petitioners are not inclined to pursue the present petition.

No directions, as such, are required to be passed.

Petition is disposed of.
