It is contended that petitioner No.1 – Sukhpreet Kaur, aged about 22 years has got married with petitioner No.2- Loveleen Kumar Gill, aged about 30 years, against the wishes of her father – Harpal Singh, arrayed as private respondent No. 4, who is threatening to interfere in their marital life, as such to seek protection in that regard, the petitioners have approached this Court by way of filing the present petition.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, to look into the

grievances of the petitioners and to take necessary measures to ensure that lives and liberty of the petitioners are not jeopardized at the hands of respondent No. 4 or persons claiming under him.

However, this order shall not validate the marriage between the petitioners and shall not have any effect on any civil or criminal action to which the petitioners may be found liable, under the law.
