The application is allowed as prayed for. In the order dated 27.09.2017, the presence of Ms. Alisha Arora, Advocate, be treated as counsel for the complainant.

Main case

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of the FIR No.117 dated 11.10.2016 registered under Sections 406, 420 and 498-A IPC at Police Station Women Cell, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR was registered at the back of the petitioner after he had left this country. The petitioner had been residing in Denmark.

It is to be seen that qua petitioner, the investigation has not commenced, therefore, this Court is not inclined to quash the FIR at this stage. However, considering the fact that the petitioner has transferred the property owned by him in the name of the complainant which is worth approximately three crore, it is ordered that in case the petitioner comes to this country within three months, he shall not be arrested in the present FIR for two weeks so that he can approach the Court for necessary protection as per law.

The petition stands disposed of.
