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**ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.100 dated 16.04.2017, under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhattu Kalan, District Fatehabad.

This is second application for regular bail. This Court by the order dated 24.08.2017 in CRM No.M-22855 of 2017 had dismissed the petition as withdrawn at that stage.

The order dated 24.08.2017 is reproduced hereunder:-

*"The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.100 dated 16.04.2017, under Section 306 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Bhattu Kalan, District Fatehabad.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the offence under Section 306 of the IPC is not made out against the petitioner as the allegations in the FIR are vague.*

*Learned State counsel states that although four prosecution witnesses have been examined and the matter is now listed on 19.09.2017 for examination of the remaining prosecution witnesses. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he wants to withdraw this petition, at this stage.*

*The petition is dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage.”*

The allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that he had allegedly developed illicit relations with the wife of Jai Karan (deceased) and had been blackmailing the deceased due to which Jai Karan along with his wife Kavita had consumed poison which led to their death. They are stated to have left behind a child of 08 years.

It is thus apparent that the allegations against the petitioner are rather serious as it is alleged that due to the illicit relations and the blackmailing on his part, two lives were lost. Even otherwise, the first bail application was dismissed as withdrawn on 24.08.2017. I do not find any good ground to entertain another application. Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
