LISA GILL, J.

The petitioner seeks quashing of order dated 30.10.2017 passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Sangrur whereby his bail bonds and surety has been cancelled, forfeited and it was directed that non-bailable warrants of arrest be issued. Notice was issued to the surety of the petitioner as well.

It is submitted that the petitioner had been regularly appearing before the learned trial Court. It is due to unavoidable circumstances that he could not appear before the learned trial Court on 30.10.2017. The petitioner undertakes to appear before the learned trial Court on each and every date fixed. Moreover, the petitioner has appeared before the learned trial Court on 16.11.2017 pursuant to interim order passed by this Court. Certified copy of order dated 29.11.2017 passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Sangrur furnished in Court today is taken on record subject to just exceptions.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Jasveer

Singh verifies that the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

He has indeed appeared before the learned trial Court pursuant to order dated 15.11.2017 passed by this Court.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances noted above but without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition. Consequently, interim bail afforded to the petitioner pursuant to order dated 15.11.2017 is made absolute subject to his submitting fresh bail bonds and surety to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
