The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.52 dated 16.03.2016 under Sections 302, 201 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Mauli Jagran, Chandigarh (U.T.).

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Admittedly, as contended by learned counsel for the U.T. Chandigarh, majority of witnesses have been examined. I have seen the evidence of Kirpal Singh (PW-6) to whom extrajudicial confession has been made by the co-accused.

There is no direct evidence in this case against the petitioner and the viscera report does not show any administration of poison.

In that view of the matter, I am inclined to grant regular bail to the petitioner. In the result, I make the following order:-

ORDER

(i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-43365-2017 is allowed.

(ii)The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the

concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.

(iii) The petitioner to surrender his passport with the trial Court, if he possesses the same.
