This is a petition filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 58 dated 17.09.2017, under Sections 389/342/506/34 IPC and 7/13(2) PC Act, registered at Police Station Mattewal, District Amritsar.

In the present case, the allegations are that the police officers, in particular the petitioner with other officers entered the shop of the complainant and demanded money and threatened him that if they are not paid the bribe, they will involve him in a case under the NDPS Act.

This Court finds that this is almost the fourth case in the present month coming before this Court. In that view of the matter, DGP, Punjab is expected to take appropriate steps for sensitizing the police officers and the police force within a period of 15 days from today and shall submit a compliance report as to what steps have been taken for controlling this menace.

In the FIR filed in this case, the name of the petitioner is not mentioned , therefore, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out. However, the petitioner is at liberty to apply for regular bail.

Petition stands disposed of.

A copy of this order be handed over dasti to learned State counsel for onward transmission.
