Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.121 dated 22.08.2015, under Sections 21, 22, 61, 85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, Amritsar.

Upon instructions from ASI Mukhwinder Singh, learned counsel for the State submits that there is no other case is pending against the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, the petitioner be released on bail, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) The **CRM-M-43393 of 2017** is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioner to surrender his passport with the trial Court, if he possesses the same.

- (iv) The petitioner would file an undertaking to the trial Court that he will not commit the same or any other kind of offence in future.
- (v) The petitioner shall report to the concerned Police Station on every Sunday between 11 am to 4 pm. The police shall keep surveillance on the petitioner.

Hence, disposed of.
