The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.45 dated 15th May, 2017, registered under Section 304 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran.

The petitioner was arrested on 22nd of May, 2017.

Investigation has since been completed and challan presented.

From the available Post-Mortem Report of the victim (Annexure P-2), it is seen that no injuries external or otherwise

were detected on the body of the deceased. The subsequent report (Annexure P-3) submitted by the Medical Board indicates death having been occasioned by natural cause (Coronary Artery Disease).

In the given circumstance, further indefinite detention of the petitioner, namely Mangbir Singh is not justified, he may therefore be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.

No part or any observation made in this order shall however influence the Ld. Trial Court which shall independently arrived at its final verdict on the evidence led in the case.
