This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 47 dated 27.06.2017, under Sections 354-A(1)(4), 354-D(2), 365, 506, 509 of the IPC, Section 25 of the Arms Act and Section 12 of the POCSO Act, registered at Police Station Women, Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he has been in custody since 07.07.2017 and after investigation, the challan has been put up. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner should be enlarged on regular bail as the trial is likely to take some time.

Mr. P. P. Chahar, DAG, Haryana, has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and contested the bail application.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner is in custody since 07.07.2017 and the trial

is likely to take some time, no useful purpose would be served in keeping him in custody furthermore. Hence, the present petition is accepted. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

However, any opinion expressed herein is for the purpose of grant of regular bail and not an opinion on the merits of the case.
