The present petition has been filed under Section 438
the Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.158 dated
30.08.2016, registered under Section 498-A IPC at Police Station
Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur.

It is contended that the petitioner is the husband. A
bare perusal of the FIR shows that only general allegations have been
levelled. There is no demand of dowry.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes
the bail application.

Heard.

As per the FIR, the petitioner along with his parents
gave beatings to the complainant as result, the complainant suffered six

injuries including injury with sharp weapon as noticed in the MLR. The petitioner allegedly tore off clothes of the complainant and tried to strangle and kill her. The petitioner is the main accused. The investigation is at the initial stage. In these circumstances, no case for grant of concession of anticipatory bail is made out. Consequently, the petition is dismissed.
