This petition for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner has been filed in criminal case bearing FIR No.43 dated 23.04.2015, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the IPC, Police Station Balongi, District S.A.S. Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner was arrested in this case on 23.04.2015 and since then he is in judicial custody.

Learned State counsel has contended that as per the information received from the quarter concerned only five PWs have been examined

before the trial Court and no other criminal case is pending against him.

Conclusion of trial will take long time, hence no useful purpose will be served by keeping him behind the bars any more. Therefore, in view of the abovesaid circumstances, this petition is accepted. Petitioner- Gurvinder Singh @ Gurpreet Singh be admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court / Duty Magistrate, Mohali. If the petitioner is holding any passport, then the same be deposited in the Court at time of furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds.

This petition stands disposed of accordingly.
