Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.749 dated 24.08.2017 registered under Section 15 of the N.D.P.S. Act, at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel inter-alia contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated on the basis of the confessional statement of co-accused which is a very weak type of evidence.

Considering over all facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted regular bail, during the trial, subject to his furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
