Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.333 dated 24.09.2017 under Sections 392, 386, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-36, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the complainant has compromised the matter with the petitioner and as per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner and co-accused namely Chhoty @ Ricky had demanded money from the complainant for doing work in his sector. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is in judicial lockup since 24.09.2017 and challan has been presented in the trial Court and it will take long time in conclusion of the trial.

Learned counsel appearing for U.T. Chandigarh, on instructions from SI Jang Bahadur Singh has not disputed the fact that the complainant

has compromised the matter with the petitioner, however, opposed the prayer for bail on the ground that the petitioner is involved in another FIR.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the fact that the complainant has compromised the matter with the petitioner; petitioner is in judicial lockup since 24.09.2017; the investigation is complete and challan has already been presented in the trial Court, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
