The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. assailing the order dated 29.09.2016 passed by the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Tosham and in terms of which the complaint lodged by the present petitioner has not been entertained and the respondents as such had not been summoned.

Counsel at the very outset prays for withdrawal of the petition to avail remedy of filing a revision against the impugned order and in the competent Court.

Prayer is allowed. Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

It is, however, made clear that in the eventuality of the petitioner preferring a revision petition, the liberty being granted by this Court would not be construed as delay, if any, having been condoned.
