Mr. Gurcharan Dass, Advocate, has appeared on behalf of respondents no. 5 to 9 and filed his power of attorney which is taken on record.

He submits that the said respondents have no objection to the marriage of the petitioners with each other but they would like to send of the girl, i.e. petitioner no. 1 from their house as per tradition so that they are not “looked down in the society in which they live”.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners have no objection to the aforesaid provided that their life and liberty is duly protected.

Consequently, petitioner no. 1 would go to her parents' house on this coming Saturday, i.e. on 06.05.2017, after first contacting the SHO Police Station Daba Shimlapuri, District Ludhiana (respondent no. 4), who would ensure that the life and liberty of the first petitioner is duly protected by sending two lady police officials along with her.

On the next day, the formal marriage ceremony would be performed as has been agreed to between the parties in Court today.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of.
